

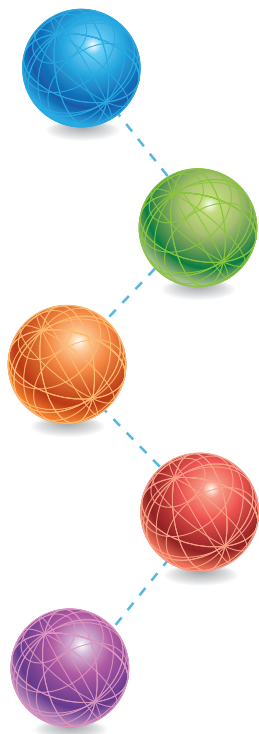

Using Information and Communications Technology to Learn

InukTIC

Everyone can learn with InukTIC. However, our project is intended primarily for students in the Québec CEGEP system.

Whether you're pursuing university studies or joining the workforce, ICT and information-searching skills are essential. This technology is now common knowledge, and is necessary for communicating with governments, employers or clients.

InukTIC is not about developing advanced computer skills – it's about helping you become autonomous in performing ICT-related tasks in your college studies, and to be better prepared to learn on your own afterward.



InukTIC is a dynamic, interactive online learning environment that lets you develop skills for searching, processing and presenting information, in a context of distance communication and collaboration.

InukTIC bases itself on the ICT and Informational Profile developed by the IT Reps network. The Profile focuses on two major goals to which the skills are connected (each skill introduces different tasks):

➤ using ICT to communicate search results: searching, processing and presenting information;

➤ distance communication and collaboration: exploiting a teaching-learning platform, and using communication and collaboration tools.

InukTIC compiles thousands of teaching and learning resources (LRs). Each resource is evaluated by experts in order to facilitate learning the ICT skills that help students succeed in their studies.

InukTIC is intended primarily for college students. However, it can also be used in a continuing education context, or by teachers who wish to improve their own abilities in ICT. The site is free and available to everyone; all users can benefit from it, if only by refreshing their memory of how to perform a certain task.

InukTIC omotes a better integration of the ICT skills that most college students must acquire in the course of their studies.

InukTIC helps users better prepare for university, a career, or everyday life.

InukTIC is subsidized by the Inukshuk foundation. The project was launched by Cégep de Lévis-Lauzon in collaboration with the IT Reps network and the Fédération des cégeps, in partnership with the CCDMD and La Vitrine Technologie-Éducation.
